


- Arabic Masjid, place for (bowing or kneeling) from which a adan, a call to prayer, is made.


 Minaret = a tall spire, traditionally used for call to prayer. This is the most distinctive feature of a mosque, although not all have them.


- Inside is the prayer hall, an open area with no furniture or chairs. Any decoration will be calligraphy from the Qur'ân.






• Niujie Mosque, Beijing (996, rebuilt 17 cent). This has a separate minaret. (smartneddy, 2006, CC-SA)








